Mapping of long-term public and private investments in the development of COVID-19 vaccines

This study provides a mapping of funds contributed by different actors for vaccine R&D and for the expansion of production capacity of COVID-19 vaccines, with the focus on the EU. The study assesses the necessity for continuing public support to R&D on vaccines. Furthermore, after highlighting current market failures, the study discusses possible new incentive mechanisms in the public interest for vaccine R&D, designed to grant equity and accessibility, as well as rewards in line with risks.
